Regulations for the Establishment of the Management
Committee for Toxic Chemicals and Other Chemicals of
Concern

- Article 1 National Taiwan University (NTU or “the University”) hereby establishes the NTU Management Committee for Toxic Chemicals and Other Chemicals of Concern (“the Committee”) under the University’s Environmental Protection and Occupational Safety and Health Committee in accordance with Article 4 of the Environmental Protection Administration’s *Regulations Governing the Handling of Toxic and Concerned Chemical Substances by Educational Institutions* to effectively manage toxic chemicals and other chemicals of concern, prevent environmental pollution, and safeguard the wellbeing of faculty, staff, and students.
- Article 2 The Committee shall be composed of 7-9 members, with the Director of the Environmental Protection and Occupational Safety and Health Center serving as chair and ex officio member, and the Head of the Chemical Hazards and Waste Management Division also serving as ex officio member. The remaining seats shall be filled by full-time faculty members who specialize in the toxicology, handling, disaster prevention, and management of toxic chemicals and other chemicals of concern, who shall be nominated by their respective colleges for appointment by the NTU President. Committee members shall be appointed to two-year terms and may serve consecutively if re-appointed.
- Article 3 The Committee shall convene semiannually. Meetings shall be chaired by the chairperson or a member appointed by the chairperson. Interim meetings may be called as necessary.
- Article 4 The Committee’s duties are as follows:
1. Formulation and implementation of regulations for the management of toxic chemicals and other chemicals of concern
 2. Formulation and implementation of disaster prevention and emergency response plans for toxic chemicals and other chemicals of concern
 3. Oversight and management of toxic chemicals and other chemicals of concern
 4. Collation and periodic reporting of the records of toxic chemicals and other chemicals of concern
- Article 5 The Committee may, with the approval of its chair, invite stakeholders to attend its meetings as non-voting members.
- Article 6 These regulations shall be passed by the Administrative Meeting and then

implemented on the date of promulgation.
